

**RESOLUTION #15 OF 2013**

**RESOLUTION OF THE MIDDLETOWN TOWN BOARD ACCEPTING  
PROPOSED LOCAL LAW TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT  
ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-c AND SCHEDULING  
PUBLIC HEARING FOR SAME**

**WHEREAS**, on June 24, 2011 the New York State Legislature enacted Chapter 97 of the NYS Laws of 2011, hereinafter referred to as the “General Municipal Law §3-c”;

**WHEREAS**, General Municipal Law §3-c expressly authorizes local governments to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of at least sixty percent (60%) of the total voting power of the governing body (in this case, the “Middletown Town Board”);

**WHEREAS**, the Attorney for the Town has prepared a proposed Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town Board has reviewed and modified the proposed Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the proposed law is ready for consideration by the Town Board; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town Board shall hold a public hearing for consideration of the Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c on September 3rd, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of said hearing in the Catskill Mountain News and to post copies of such notice in the manner provided by law.
